CITY ADVISORY BOARDS & COMMISSIONS

BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT: Five-member board that hears applications for variances in zoning issues and appeals of administrative decisions.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Seven to Fifteen member board that hears conditional use permits, rezonings, preliminary and final plats and makes recommendations to the City Council.

MUNICIPAL CEMETERY BOARD: Nine-member advisory board that offers suggestions pertaining to the operation of the cemetery.

PARKS & RECREATION BOARD: Nine-member advisory board to the Council to promote recreation in the City of El Dorado Springs.

PICNIC BOARD: Eleven-member board that plans and organizes the annual celebration known as the Founder's Day Picnic.

* Based on average of actual water usage during January, February and March. Subsequent 12 month's charges are based on this calculated average, to allow for summer water usage that does not go down the sewer.

Trash Service:

\$ 8.99 per month

Trash charges are billed on the City utility bills for Waste Corporation of America. The City does not provide trash service, simply billing and collection for the trash hauler.

TRASH COLLECTION

Waste Corporation of America provides trash service to the City of El Dorado Springs for residential and is available for commercial trash service.

Once a week, curbside solid waste trash pick-up is provided to residents at a cost of \$8.99 per month.

YOUR TRASH DAY IS _____.

Recycling bins are located northwest of the City Cemetery by the transfer station. Items accepted are aluminum cans, steel food cans, glass bottles, jars and plastic bottles. There is a separate bin for newspapers only.

A transfer station is located northwest of the City Cemetery off of Hainline Road. Contact Waste Corporation of America for information and pricing.

A compost pile for brush and leaves is located by the transfer station.

Hours for the transfer station and compost pile are 8:30 am - 4:30 pm Monday through Friday.

Businesses may contact City Hall for commercial trash information.

Quad-Lakes Solid Waste Management District brings a truck to collect paper for recycling. The truck is located in the City Hall parking lot on the 4th Thursday of each month from 8 am—11 am. Items accepted, must be brought in separated are:

- Office paper (white)
- Mixed paper (colored)
- Newspaper
- Magazines, Catalogs, Phone Books

EL DORADO SPRINGS PARKS AND RECREATION

The City of El Dorado Springs maintains a City park in the downtown business district. This park is a focal point of the community. In fact, the town was founded in 1881 around a spring that still flows in the park. The park is the site of an annual founder's day picnic each year in mid-July. Approximately 30,000 people attend the three-day event. Sharing center stage with the spring is the Municipal Band which plays on Friday, Saturday and Sunday evening during the summer months. The park also features a community building, shelter houses, tennis courts, playground equipment, barbecue pits and picnic tables.

The Community Building may be reserved for your own personal use — family reunion, birthday party, dances, etc. Contact the Civic Center for reservations and fee information. The fee and deposit is to be paid at the time the application is filled out.

Shelter houses are available on a first come, first serve basis at no charge.

The City also maintains a park adjacent to the Lucien Carter Ball Park. This park features two lighted outdoor basketball courts. The park also has picnic tables and playground equipment.

A third City park is located at Carman & Main. This park features a backstop and a walking trail. You will find a shelter house, picnic tables, barbeque grills and playground equipment located here in our newest park.

CIVIC CENTER

In 2005, the City of El Dorado Springs opened a new Civic Center. The Center is located downtown at 135 W Spring and features a gymnasium, indoor walking track, fitness room, racquetball/handball court, game room and meeting rooms/full kitchen. There are no membership dues and the facility is virtually free to use except for the racquetball court and meeting rooms. Hours are Monday-Thursday 8:00 am-9:00 pm, Friday-Saturday 8:00 am-10:00 pm and Sunday 2:00 pm-6:00 pm. Contact the Center for general information, reservations and/or fee information (where applicable). Fees and deposits for reservations must be paid at the time the application is filled out.

GENE PRAY MEMORIAL GOLF COURSE

The City Golf Course is located at the end of West Fields Ext. The green fees are \$10.00 per day Monday-Friday; \$13.00 on Saturday, Sunday and holidays. Season passes are available at City Hall for \$325.00 per individual pass and \$100.00 for each additional immediate family member. Student passes are available for \$100.00. Cart rental is available at the golf course. Cart trail fee is \$100.00 annually. Junior fee information is available at the golf course or City Hall.

SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAM

The Lucien Carter Ball Park is located at the end of West Fields Ext. The ball fields are used for organized league team practice during the month of May. Reservations for these four (4) ball diamonds are taken at City Hall.

Signups are held in March of each year. Please watch the newspapers or our website for signup information.

Around the first of June, the scheduled league games begin. The children will be divided into leagues by age as of April 30. Birth certificates are required for verification.

Players must live in the El Dorado Springs R-2 School District.

T-BALL: Any child in age 4 or 5.

The ball is hit off a tee, which is positioned at home plate.

BOYS OR GIRLS COACHES PITCH: Any child age 6 or 7.

The ball is pitched by a coach.

MINOR BOYS LEAGUE: Any boy 8, 9 or 10.

The ball is fast pitched to the batter.

MAJOR BOYS LEAGUE: Any boy age 11, 12 or 13.

The play is fast pitch baseball.

SENIOR BOYS LEAGUE: Any boy age 14, 15 or 16.

The play is fast pitch baseball.

JUNIOR GIRLS SOFTBALL: Any girl age 8, 9 or 10.

The ball is fast pitched to the batter.

MAJOR GIRLS SOFTBALL: Any girl age 11, 12 or 13.

The ball is fast pitched to the batter.

SENIOR GIRLS SOFTBALL: Any girl age 14, 15 or 16.

The ball is fast pitched to the batter.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

VOTER REGISTRATION SERVICE: Available during regular business hours at City Hall. See the City Clerk.

GARAGE SALE PERMITS: A permit shall be obtained before a garage sale is held at a fee of \$1.00 per day. Garage sales are limited to two (2) consecutive days and no more than two (2) separate sales per household per year.

BUILDING PERMITS: Building permits are required for all new residential and commercial buildings. Permits are also required for any additions, enlargements or alterations of walls, structures or buildings, or demolition of a structure. Re-roofs and fences require a permit when within the City of El Dorado Springs. Electrical and plumbing permits are also required.

All permits can be obtained from City Hall after approval from the Code Official. The cost of the permit depends upon the type of project and the cost of the project.

EL DORADO SPRINGS TAXI SERVICE: The hours of the taxi service are Monday thru Saturday 7:30 am - 4:30 pm. The driver does take a lunch break. The taxi dispatcher takes calls from 7:30 am—4:00 pm at 876-6576. The cost of the taxi service is \$1.00 for a one-way ride within the City limits and \$2.00 for a one-way ride within a 2-mile radius outside the City limits.

MERCHANT LICENSES: A merchant license is required to run a business in El Dorado Springs. State law requires a business to provide their retail sales license, if applicable, to City Hall before a local merchant license can be issued. For information regarding your legal requirements to have a retail sales license, please contact the Missouri Department of Revenue. Contact City Hall for more information.

ZONING: The City of El Dorado Springs is zoned. Zoning divides the City into three basic zones — residential, commercial and industrial. Zoning prohibits these activities from taking place outside their respective areas. This minimizes conflicts created when these activities are mixed together in close quarters.

IMPORTANT: Before you buy or rent property or build buildings CHECK ZONING REGULATIONS. Also check sewer, water and electric service availability.

ANIMAL REGULATIONS: All dogs and cats are required to be on a leash or confined at all times.

Dogs in El Dorado Springs are required to be vaccinated against rabies and have a Dog Tag. The tag is for the protection of the owner as well as the animal. The tag also serves as an excellent form of identification for any dog in the event that they are lost.

The tags are available at City Hall during normal business hours and are good for the period of one (1) year and must be renewed each year in June. The cost of tags are \$2.00 each for male or spayed female, \$3.00 for unspayed female. Proof of rabies vaccination must be presented at time of purchase.

There shall be no more than two (2) dogs per each household.

Animal Control can be contacted by calling the Police Department at 876-2313.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

DRIVER'S & VEHICLE LICENSE: There is currently no local license office. The nearest Missouri Department of Revenue offices are located in Nevada at 429 W Walnut (448-5705), at 534 West St, Stockton (276-2228) and at Do It Best Home Center, Osceola (646-2901). Driver's exams are given on Monday in Lamar, first and third Tuesday in Osceola, Wednesday in Greenfield, second, fourth and fifth Tuesday and every Thursday in Nevada and Friday in Stockton. Missouri Driver's Guides are available at the Police Department and City Hall. New Missouri residents are required to obtain a state driver's and vehicle license immediately.

MARRIAGE LICENSE: Available from the Circuit Clerk and Recorder's Office at the Cedar County Courthouse in Stockton. Information can be obtained by calling 276-6700.
